Open to Government & Academic Institutions

Government Institutions are defined as a national, international, regional, or local government entity, or publicly controlled or funded agency or enterprise that delivers public programs, goods, or services. Full-time government employees with a valid government issued email address are eligible.

Academic Institutions are defined as a non-profit or public 4-year university or 2-year college. Full- or part-time Professors and full-time faculty and staff with a valid University/college issued email address are eligible.

MEMBERSHIP DUES

All memberships are based on a calendar year and will expire on December 31 when joining between January and September. As a convenience, members joining between October and December will receive membership for the current year and the next year. Public Member and Corporate Member offer prorated dues for those joining later in the year.
